<i>Brilliant lemon–green in color offering enticing aromas of acacia flowers, citrus, tangerine and hints of almonds.</i>			
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Twin Islands, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>9.5</b>	<b>22</b>	<b>34</b>
<i>A lively fragrance combines tropical fruits, citrus peel and fresh herbs. The palate is crisp and intense showing grapefruit flavours with hints of fresh coriander and thyme which lead to a mouth–watering and zesty finish.</i>			
<b>Chenin Blanc–Vioigner, Pine Ridge, Clarksburg/Lodi, California</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>23</b>	<b>36</b>
<i>This extraordinary blend opens with a juicy honeydew melon, sweet white peach and ripe green plum touched with hints of spiced white tea and soft apple blossom.</i>

<i>Intense aromas of peaches, rose petals and ginger. Pale sunshine–yellow in color with a slight frizzante. Delicately sweet, modest acidity with a finish of fresh apricots.</i>			
<b>Chardonnay, Catena, Mendoza, Argentina</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>26</b>	<b>38</b>
<i>White fruit aromas of peach and pear interwoven with delicate citrus and floral notes. The palate shows rich and concentrated ripe pear, apple and apricot flavors with a light note of minerality.</i>			
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Emmolo, Napa Valley</b>	<b>11.5</b>	<b>28</b>	<b>39</b>
<i>Aromas are fresh and clean, evoking the scent of early morning after a first rain, with a hint of honeysuckle and underlying notes of tangerine, grapefruit and wet stone. A long–lasting, zesty minerality leaves the sensation of both subtly and brightness.</i>			
<b>Albariño, Adegas Morgadio “Legado del Conde”, Rias Baixas, Spain</b>			<b>39</b>
<i>Highly aromatic, complex bouquet evokes pear, white peach, melon and white flowers. Round and supple in texture, with deep honeydew and pit fruit flavors that expand with air.</i>			
<b>Chardonnay, Flora Springs, Napa Valley</b>	<b>12.5</b>	<b>30</b>	<b>41</b>
<i>This wine explodes with ripe apple, pear and white peaches, followed by crisp grapefruit with hints of jasmine.</i>			
<b>Riesling, Trimbach, Alsace, France</b>			<b>44</b>
<i>Ripe fruits on the palate, white peach, quince, grapefruit with good ripe acidity on the finish ensuring some good ageing potential.</i>			
<b>Pinot Gris, Domaines Schlumberger, Alsace, France</b>	<b>14</b>	<b>34</b>	<b>49</b>
<i>Buttercup yellow with gold reflections. Aromas of earthy apple and quince, white peach, hints of smoke and lemon. Primary flavors when tasting are similar to the bouquet with a lovely mouthfeel and a soft, bright finish.</i>			
<b>Chardonnay, Beaulieu Vineyards, Carneros</b>	<b>15</b>	<b>37</b>	<b>52</b>
<i>Aromas of fresh pear, citrus and golden delicious apples mingled with honey, white flowers and toasted hazelnut. The silken–textured flavors reveal expressive apricot and peach notes, culminating in a lemon custard finish with a beautiful balance of bright, crisp acidity and opulent creaminess.</i>			
<b>Sancerre, Jolivet, Loire Valley, France</b>			<b>54</b>
<i>Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity is tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean. Alive, racy and youthful.</i>			
<b>Chardonnay, Patz &amp; Hall, 2012, Sonoma</b>			<b>62</b>
<i>Beautiful peach, green apple and roasted hazelnut aromas framed by clove spice. Bright, intricate flavors that are refreshing, cleansing and great with food.</i>			
<b>Chardonnay, Frank Family, 2012, Carneros</b>			<b>67</b>
<i>This Carneros Chardonnay is fruit forward and balanced, delivering scents of pear, apple, butterscotch and pineapple. Laced with delicate floral notes of honeysuckle.</i>

<b>Riesling, Jean Baptiste Adam ‘Kaefferkopf’, 2011, Alsace, France</b>	<b>72</b>
<i>This Grand Cru has a nose of candied peach and mango with subtle notes of acacia flowers, enhanced through subtle mineral notes.</i>	
<b>Chardonnay, Catena Alta, 2012, Mendoza, Argentina</b>	<b>76</b>
<i>The Catena Chardonnay combines the unique expressions of three high altitude vineyard sites. The wine shows intense straw yellow color with greenish highlights. The combination of vineyards offers aromas of tropical fruits with notes of peaches, white flowers and spicy vanilla.</i>	
<b>Meursault, Olivier Leflaive, 2011, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>78</b>
<i>A classic Meursault nose speaks of hazelnut, acacia blossom and freshly sliced lemon. There is good volume and verve to the round, supple and voluminous middle weight flavors that culminate in a persistent and dry finish.</i>	
<b>Chardonnay, Paul Hobbs “Russian River,” 2012, Sonoma</b>	<b>86</b>
<i>Lustrous golden hue with lively aromas of yellow flowers, custard, mandarin oil and stone fruit. The richly textured, seamlessly structured palate is layered with stone fruits, lemon zest, melon and apple.</i>

<i>Wonderfully developed plum, vanilla and leather aromas swirl in the glass. Juicy flavors of cherry candy coupled with hints of cocoa powder weave through the palate.</i>			
<b>Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato, DOC, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>9.5</b>	<b>22</b>	<b>34</b>
<i>Ruby–red in color, this Valpolicella Classico Superiore offers fleshy aromas of wild berries, currant, black cherry and spice with hints of chocolate.</i>			
<b>Red Blend, Treo, Hess Select, California</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>23</b>	<b>36</b>
<i>A blend of merlot, syrah and petite sirah has aromas of wild berry, plum, vanilla and black currant jam. It enters the palate with juicy flavors of cranberry, pomegranate and black cherry, while the finish is long and soft.</i>			
<b>Shiraz, Paringa, Victoria, Australia</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>23</b>	<b>36</b>
<i>It has an aroma of intense blackberry and black currants that are contrasted with cinnamon and nutmeg spices, balanced by a hint of mocha, oak influence and soft tannins.</i>			
<b>Cotes–du–Rhône, Pierre Amadieu, Rhone Valley, France</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>23</b>	<b>36</b>
<i>Aromas of raspberry, strawberry, violets and subtle pepper. This myriad of flavors joins the palate in balanced harmony with additional characters of blackberry and lifted spice.</i>			
<b>Malbec, Catena “Vista Flores” Mendoza, Argentina</b>	<b>10.5</b>	<b>25</b>	<b>37</b>
<i>Dark violet color, rich and explosive, with dark fruit aromas intermingled with delicate floral notes and a touch of anise. Ripe black cherry and black raspberry fruit flavors layered with notes of spice cake and a touch of tobacco.</i>			
<b>Red Blend, Pepperjack, Barossa Valley, Australia</b>	<b>11</b>	<b>26</b>	<b>38</b>
<i>Upfront fruit with a soft round structure and a slight hint of oak. The aromas and flavors show fresh berries, plums and vanilla. Fine–grained tannins with lingering blackberry and raspberry extending through some spice and earth notes.</i>			
<b>Pinot Noir, Erath, Oregon</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>29</b>	<b>40</b>
<i>Pure wafts of red plum and raspberry intertwine with spice, soft sage and an intriguing hint of cracked pepper. The palate features flavors of juicy Bing cherry, cranberry cocktail and a late kiss of vanilla spice.</i>			
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Joel Gott “815,” California</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>29</b>	<b>40</b>
<i>Aromas of plum, raspberry and cherry cola with hints of anise, cocoa, leather and dried herbs. Bright acidity on the front of the palate leads to a complex mid–palate and soft tannins on the finish.</i>			

<b>Merlot, Rutherford Hill, Napa Valley</b>	<b>45</b>		
<i>An abundance of cherry fruit flavors are backed by rich, balanced structure for an intensely complex Merlot. Silky, full flavored and firm. Built with smooth tannins and lush layers of flavor.</i>			
<b>Viña Alberdi Reserva, La Rioja Alta, Rioja, Spain</b>	<b>46</b>		
<i>Intense aroma, predominant ripe red berries with balsamic scents, coffee and coconut. Well–balanced on the palate with a silky mouth feel, pleasant acidity that highlights a fresh and long–lasting aftertaste.</i>			
<b>Pinot Noir, “A” by Acacia, Central Coast</b>	<b>15</b>	<b>37</b>	<b>52</b>
<i>A versatile wine that reveals itself in elegant turns–from vibrant red cherry, raspberry and juicy dark plum, to hints of sun–warmed red rose petal and fragrant oak spices. Supple, fine–grained tannins softly frame this Pinot Noir’s fruit forward, cashmere–textured flavors.</i>			
<b>Grenache, Shatter, Maury, France</b>	<b>15</b>	<b>37</b>	<b>52</b>
<i>Aromas of toasted French oak and brioche mingle with fresh cut strawberry and candied cherries. The entry of the wine is rich and mouth coating offering a melange of kirsch and dark stone fruits leading into a soft and lingering finish with just a touch of bright acidity.</i>			

<b>Gigondas, “Pierre Aiguille” Jaboulet, Rhone Valley, France</b>	<b>54</b>
<i>Bright red color, enlivened with purplish tinges. Generous and very aromatic. Impressions of game, red fruit and vegetal aromas that recall its native Southern Garrigue region.</i>	
<b>Cabernet Franc, “Gamling &amp; McDuck”, 2011, Napa Valley</b>	<b>58</b>
<i>Lilac and spice on the nose. Round and opulent cassis and blueberry fruit on the palate with driving acidity. Bright, textured and polished finish. Five barrels made.</i>	
<b>Bandol, Domaine Terrebrune, 2010, Provence, France</b>	<b>62</b>
<i>This wine is more mineral, and earthy, as savory as grilled meat. With air, a deep cherry note rings out while musky orange blossom scents rise above it.</i>	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags’ Leap, 2012 Napa Valley</b>	<b>67</b>
<i>Layered, lush and blackberry–driven, this wine is a beautiful example of Napa Valley Cabernet. Classic black currant, black cherry and plum flavors with interwoven notes of black pepper, licorice, caramel and chocolate.</i>	

<b>Pinot Noir, Frank Family, 2012, Carneros</b>	<b>68</b>
<i>Bright ruby core and opens with aromas of black cherries, sassafras, raspberry, dried fruits, mushrooms and spice. The palate is full–bodied, generously loaded with fresh blueberry compote flavors and lush savory notes that lead to roasted figs.</i>	
<b>Petite Sirah, Biale “Basic Black”, 2010, Napa Valley</b>	<b>70</b>
<i>Deep, layered, long and decadent. Currant preserves, blueberry turnover, fine–grained, layered and elegant. Finishes with nuances of clove, espresso, licorice and warm stones.</i>	

<b>Pinot Noir, Belle Glos “Dairyman,” 2013, Russian River Valley</b>	<b>72</b>
<i>Dark in hue, rich and dense, this offers a potent mix of berry pie flavors that are lively, complex and well–oaked. Quite harmonious, with the fruit and creamy wood scents in sync.</i>	
<b>Red Blend, Gaja Ca’marcanda ‘Promis’, Bolgheri, 2012, Tuscany</b>	<b>78</b>
<i>Balanced, almost musical, this amazing ‘Super Tuscan’ combines the elegance and suppleness of Merlot and Syrah with the austerity and spice of Sangiovese.</i>	
<b>Meritage, Trilogy, Flora Springs, 2011, Napa Valley</b>	<b>84</b>
<i>Ripe berries, all spice, white chocolate, espresso and black currant. The Merlot brings out the red fruits, while the Cabernet and Malbec are responsible for the black fruits.</i>	

<b>Pinot Noir, Domaine Anderson, 2012, Anderson Valley</b>	<b>85</b>
<i>A bright and lucid expression of Pinot Noir’s captivating virtues, this wine fills the palate with black cherry, raspberry, and sumptous red plum. A breath of clove lends perfect balance to this wine.</i>	
<b>Merlot, Shafer, 2012, Napa Valley</b>	<b>86</b>
<i>Fragrant aroma through the round, full mouth to its long, polished finish. This wine offers both layered complexity and easy–to–love juiciness. Red and black cherry, red and black plum, smoke, white pepper, sage, oregano and wet earth.</i>	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Jordan, 2010, Alexander Valley</b>	<b>91</b>
<i>Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and cassis mingle with hints of violet and dark chocolate to seduce and intrigue.</i>	
<b>Merlot, Pride Mountain Vineyards, 2012, Napa Valley</b>	<b>92</b>
<i>A sumptuous nose of bright plum, cherry, rose petal, mulberry and walnut introduces an enticing wine that sets the taste buds firing. The palate is layered and lush, expressing undulating waves of red fruit woven together by a rich mid–palate and vibrant acidity.</i>	

<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Hess Collection, 2011, Mount Veeder</b>	<b>96</b>
<i>Vibrant red fruit, with aromas and flavors of cherry and raspberry counter–balanced with anise, black pepper spice and cedary notes from oak aging. A pleasant, medium–body with appealing tannins. Hints of cherry and cola spice on the finish.</i>	
<b>Chalk Hill Estate Blend, 2011, Sonoma</b>	<b>106</b>
<i>The nose is composed of opulent aromas including black cherry, blackberry, plum jam, provencal herbs, vanilla, and pipe tobacco. The flavors are equally lush with additional notes of spicy oak, vanilla, blueberry pie, and bittersweet chocolate.</i>	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak, 2010, Alexander Valley</b>	<b>108</b>
<i>A complex wine with berry and floral aromatics. It has a dark ruby color and a vibrant nose of black cherry, wisteria and sweet baking spices.</i>	
<b>Brunello di Montalcino, Altesino, DOCG, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>110</b>
<i>The bouquet displays ample aromas of violet, wild berries, tobacco, chocolate and vanilla. On the palate, this Brunello offers a rich, full–bodied experience.</i>	

<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Caymus, 2012, Napa Valley</b>	<b>114</b>
<i>Dark, scarlet red color, with powerful aromas of sweet ripe Cabernet grapes. Initial impressions are fantastically appealing, brooding to expansive textural sensations of finely grained cacao tannins.</i>	
<b>Amarone, Tommasi, 2010, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>118</b>
<i>Aromas of vanilla bean, coffee bean, and mocha introduce this classic Merlot. Dark chocolate covered cherries, caramel and nutmeg flavors.</i>	
<b>Pinot Noir, Domaine Faiveley, 1er Cru “Clos de l’écu,” 2012, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>124</b>
<i>A silky texture buoys the cherry, raspberry and mineral flavors, while bright acidity keeps them focused. This is balanced and long, with a spicy, stony after taste.</i>	
<b>Tignanello, Antinori, 2010, Toscana, Italy</b>	<b>138</b>
<i>A wine that impresses for its sublime elegance and precision. Understated layers of fruit caress the palate like cashmere in this impeccable, soft wine. Cedar, graphite, sweet herbs, licorice and leather add complexity to a core of highly expressive red fruits.</i>
